Self Paced

A key feature of the Discover Sewing afterschool club is selfpaced learning. Over twelve weeks, youth complete projects at their own pace. While one student might be finishing a pillowcase, the next might be starting a scrunchie.

The Discover Sewing 4-H Afterschool club has been offered to students annually for three years. Youth utilize sewing equipment and technology to create a number of different projects, such as pillowcases, aprons, pillows and more. Along with STEAM based learning, youth gain mastery by progressing through projects.

The Discover Sewing club is one of several topic-based clubs, that provides youth the opportunity explore their interests and discover their sparks.
